

Changes in the education system implemented at Epoka University as of the 2013-2014 academic year

Text based on the Decision of the University Administrative Board No. 2, dated 07.10.2013, Decision of the University Administrative Board No. 6, dated 25.11.2013, Decision of the University Administrative Board No. 2, dated 16.12.2013 and the Decision of Senate No. 3, dated 03.02.2014

General rules

- There will be no Mid-term Make-up Exams as of the 2013-2014 academic year.
- There will be no Make-up Exam for Final Exams.
- Students in Bachelor study programs and the Integrated Second Cycle study program in Architecture whose CGPA is less than 1.80 starting from the end of the fourth semester, will be able to take at most two courses that do not exceed 15 ECTS from the subsequent semester.
- Minimum attendance requirement will also apply to students who repeat the course because of lack of success.

Course Withdrawal

- Course withdrawals can be done during the 11th week of the Fall and Spring Semester.
- One course at most can be withdrawn in one semester.
- Four courses at most can be withdrawn throughout all education period.¹
- Course withdrawal cannot be done in the first two semesters of the curriculum.
- All courses – regardless whether they are taken for the first time or are repeated courses – may be withdrawn.

Resit Exams

- All students will be able to enter Resit Exams to be organised at the end of the Fall and Spring Semester.
- There will be no limitation concerning the number of Resit Exams a student will be able to enter among the courses that s/he registered for that particular semester.
- Resit Exams are administered for courses taken during the Fall and Spring Semesters; they are not administered for courses taken during the Summer Semester.
